


CITY OF WEST FORK WEST FORK, ARKANSAS ROADWAY TYPICAL SECTIONS








MINOR COLLECTOR ROADWAY



NOTE: WHEN PLANTING TREES BEHIND THE ROADWAY CURB IN A TREE LAWN OR STREETSCAPE, STRUCTURAL SOILS SHALL BE USED TO PROMOTE HEALTHY ROOT GROWTH AND MINIMIZE ROOT DAMAGE TO PAVEMENTS. REFER TO THE TABLE FOR THE VOLUME OF STRUCTURAL SOIL TO BE USED PER TREE, BASED ON THE APPROXIMATE MATURE SPREAD OF THE TREE'S CANOPY.

Tree Type	Mature Crown Spread	Soil Necessary Per Tree	Volume of Loamy Soil Necessary at Tree Well Opening (Min. 50 SF Opening)
Small Tree	20'	375 cubic feet (C.F.)	100 C.F.
Medium Tree	30'	1037 C.F.	100 C.F.
Large Tree	40'	2262 C.F.	100 C.F.

NOTE: TREE WELLS SHOULD BE PLACED EVERY 40' WHEN POSSIBLE UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
