The analysis provides insight into where infrastructure investments, such as better signage, crosswalks, or lighting, could significantly improve safety for drivers and pedestrians. 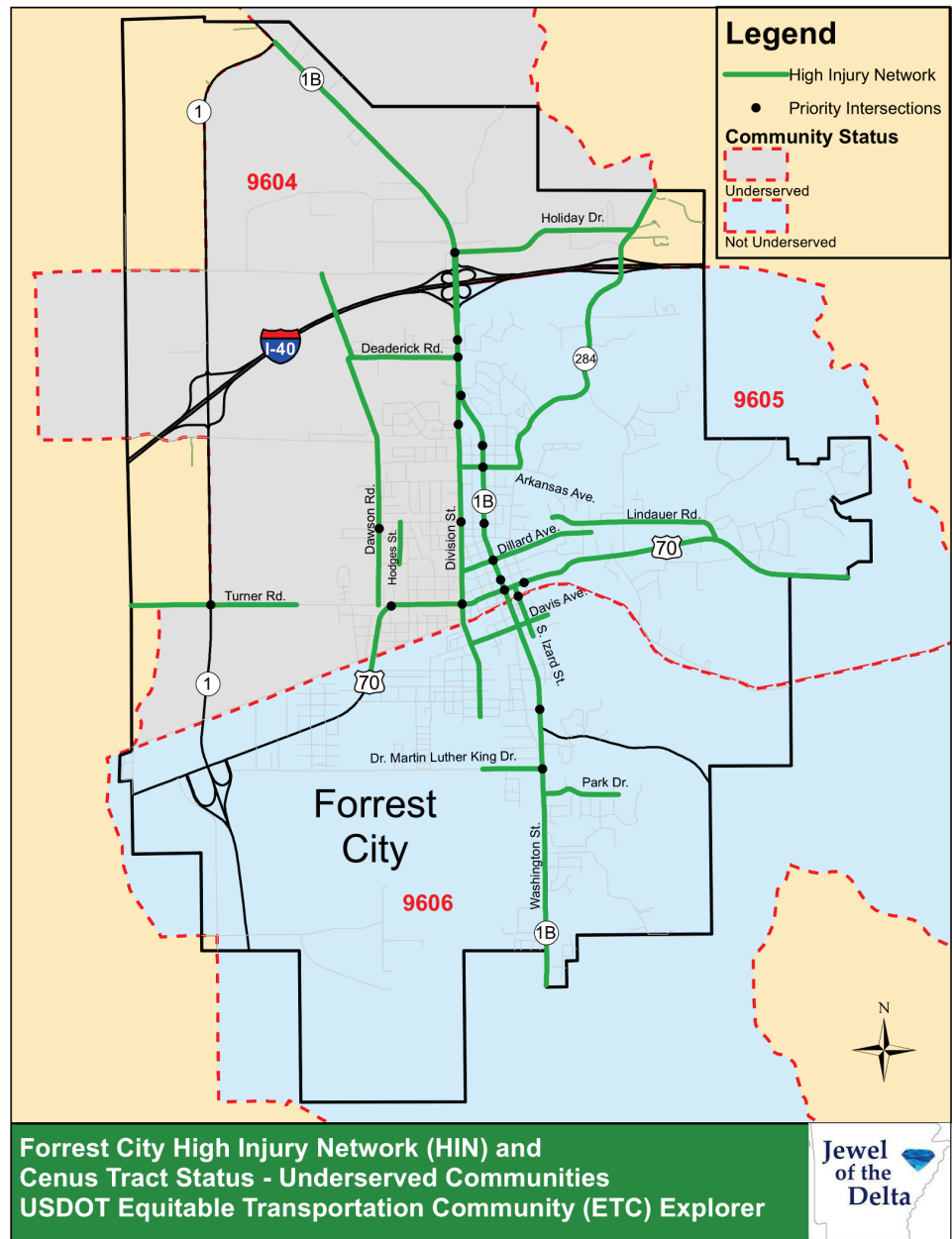
