



As the city and population grows to the north, an additional north/south minor collector connection located west of Campbell Ave will be necessary to provide a safe and convenient circulation of vehicular and pedestrian traffic from Granite Road to Phillips Street. In order for the proposed minor collector alignment to be an effective and safe connection, the intersection with Phillips Street must be aligned with or located to the west of the existing School Street intersection. Due to existing physical constraints, including topography and floodplain, as well as the location of existing development, the recommended intersection alignment area is shown as a hatched area, and the precise alignment shall be determined with further study once the connection is warranted by future development. For safety reasons, an intersection alignment which creates an offset intersection is highly discouraged.
