Dear Secretary Buttigieg,

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) is fully supportive of the Circuit Engineering District #8 application for Bridge Investment Program (BIP) grant funding to replace seven bridges in six rural counties in northwestern Oklahoma. This grant will improve bridges that are currently in fair or poor condition, have insufficient widths and are load posted, making them unsuitable to carry vehicles, school buses or large agricultural equipment.

These bridges are either at or beyond their useful lives, having been constructed between 1915 and 1981. Like bridges across the country, these bridges are in need of significant investment to bring them out of a structurally deficient rating or prevent them from falling into that category. Investing today will prevent greater needed investments in the future and will avoid costly detours should the bridges further deteriorate and require closure.

CED #8 has responsibility of over 14 counties in one of the most rural parts of Oklahoma. With limited funding, the CED is unable to meet all the infrastructure needs within its boundaries. BIP funding would allow CED #8 to let a single contract for all seven bridges included in this request and take advantage of the cost and time savings of bundling.

This project will support critical state of good repair, safety and mobility goals for Oklahoma's county bridge system as well as the residents and economy of the northwest region. I strongly support this application and requests your favorable review.
