WHAT IS THE LAND USE STUDY?

A land use study is an inventory and high-level analysis of a multitude of data related to infrastructure, land use, community demographics, and amenities. Through a public involvement process with residents, stakeholders, an advisory committee, and others, the study will lead to an overall vision and set of goals for the future growth of Pulaski County. The Vision and Goals are key to informing the development of the plan.

ELEMENTS OF THE LAND USE PLAN

The land use plan will be a resource and policy guide to be utilized by the Planning Board, Quorum Court, and community as future land use, development, and redevelopment is considered. The plan sets broad goals and objectives and includes implementation recommendations. Elements include:

- Future land use map with land use categories identified
- Master Road/Transportation plan with typical cross sections
- Broad based assessment of future infrastructure needs and recommendations
- Implementation plan
