

# Hwy. 183 - Pulaski Co. Line (Hwy. 5)

## What is the Highway 5 Project?

The Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) is proposing to widen 3.2 miles of Highway 5 between N. Reynolds Road (Highway 183) and N. Alexander Road (Pulaski County Line) in Saline County. Currently, this section of Highway 5 is a two-lane, open-shoulder road. The proposed improvements would widen Highway 5 to four lanes with a painted median along with curb and gutter and match the adjacent Highway 5 sections to the east and west of the project. A 10-foot-wide sidepath is proposed on the north side of Highway 5 and a 5-foot-wide sidewalk on the south. A signalized intersection at Midland Road and upgrades to existing signals at Bryant Parkway have been added to the design.

## Why are We Meeting Today?

ARDOT and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) are conducting a Location and Design Public Hearing to present and discuss the design plans and Environmental Assessment (EA) for the proposed widening of Highway 5 between N. Reynolds Road (Highway 183) and N. Alexander Road (Pulaski County Line) in Saline County.

The EA promotes informed decision making in the development of a transportation solution(s) by explaining the purpose of the proposed action, evaluating social, economic, and environmental impacts, soliciting feedback from the public and decision-makers, and determining whether further analysis is necessary or if the impacts are minimal enough to warrant a Finding of No Significant Impacts (FONSI).

## What Happens After This Hearing?

The FHWA and ARDOT invite interested individuals and entities to provide comments. The design plans and EA and appendices can be viewed and downloaded from the project website. After a review of comments received from citizens, public officials, and public agencies, a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) document will be prepared for review by the FHWA. If the FHWA approves the FONSI, it will conclude the environmental process and right-of-way acquisition can begin.
