What is the US 72 Improvements Project?

The Mississippi Department of Transportation (MDOT) has scheduled an open forum public meeting to discuss proposed alternatives to provide safe and efficient access to the Chickasaw Industrial Park, and more specifically the planned battery plant, from US 72 and State Route 302 (SR 302) in Marshall County.

The project study area includes an approximately 1.5-mile-long segment of US 72 from just west of the interchange with SR 302 west to Knox Road. The project will include an interchange and the addition of frontage roads. This segment of US 72 would be fully controlled to improve overall traffic operations.

Why are We Meeting Today?

MDOT and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) are conducting an open forum public meeting to present and discuss proposed alternatives for the US 72 Improvements project. We are meeting to encourage public participation in this project. Please provide any relevant information to assist MDOT in developing the best project for this community.

The format for the meeting is an open house, which means there is no formal presentation. You are encouraged to view the maps and materials, ask questions, and provide comments to our staff. Your comments are very important and could help shape the nature of future improvements. Comments may be submitted through Friday, June 14, 2024.

What Comes Next?

Comments received during the comment period (May 30 – June 14) will be reviewed and considered in future designs. The Environmental Assessment will be completed, and another public meeting will be held to present and discuss the findings.
