

Highway 12 - Highway 279 Intersection Improvements

Bentonville, Arkansas (Benton County)



Project Background

- The purpose of this project is to improve the intersection of Highway 12 and Highway 279 in the City of Bentonville, Arkansas.
- The proposed intersection improvements include the construction of a two-lane roundabout with dual left turns, roadway approach improvements, drainage improvements, and sidewalk and shared-use path construction. Specifically, the design allows for more efficient traffic flow and reduces the need for lane changes within the roundabout.
- Additional features include the addition of a 12-foot-wide multi-use path and a 5-foot-wide sidewalk along the roadways, curb and gutter installations, and an enclosed drainage system. The project will require about 3.66 acres of additional right-of-way, 1.09 acres of permanent grading/drainage easements, and 0.49 acres of temporary construction easements, pending final design approval.
