Thoroughfare Class and R.O.W. Programming

One role of the Thoroughfare Plan is to guide the design and construction of streets to meet vehicular, pedestrian, bicycle, and transit demands of the community. As a means to promote consistency and equity in the application of resources and infrastructure, the thoroughfare plan has different class designations that reflect the corresponding demands.

The City has undertaken a series of neighborhood district plans that have used the guidance from the City of Temple's Comprehensive Plan 2020 to create context sensitive solutions for implementation of the Thoroughfare Plan. The corresponding cross section below highlight programing of the right-of-way and in a way that is intended meet the needs of all users for that respective class designation.


Major Arterial TMED Plan: 31st Street
