Review

FHWA and ARDOT will review all comments received within the comment period. The public comment period will end November 8, 2023.



Selected Alternative

Project revisions will be made based on the received comments. The Environmental Assessment (EA) will be completed and a meeting will be held to present the findings. Based on the EA findings, a preferred alternative may then be identified and final approval by the FHWA may be requested to identify the Selected Alternative.



Schedule and Funding

The environmental process is expected to be complete in fall 2024. At that point, right-of-way acquisition could begin.

The City of Pocahontas has partnered with the Department to construct the bypass. The City will contribute \$1.6 million for the construction. This project is identified for funding in ARDOT's 2023-2026 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program.

After the project is complete, the City will assume ownership and responsibility of Highway 90 from Highway 67 to the proposed bypass, Highway 115 from Highway 90 to the proposed bypass, and Highway 304N from Highway 67 to Highway 304.
