Why Are We Having This Meeting?

The purpose of this public meeting is to allow the public the opportunity to **review and comment** on the need for and feasibility of improvements to vehicular, pedestian, and bicycle traffic flow in downtown Searcy.

The **Searcy transportation network** is oriented in an east-west fashion, with Highway 16/67B (Race Avenue) and Highway 36 (Beebe Capps Expressway) as the primary east-west arterials. Highway 67B (Main Street) is the only north-south arterial in central Searcy, and the lack of alternate routes creates a bottleneck downtown where Main Street connects Race Avenue to Beebe Capps Expressway.

The format for this meeting is an **open house**, which means there is no formal presentation. You are encouraged to view the maps and materials, ask questions, and provide comments. Your comments are very important and could help shape future improvements.
